The Lord spoke to us during the Conference with the following prophetic words and sharings from the audience.

The dictionary states that the definition for "NEW" means: begin afresh, refreshed, rejuvenated, different and distinct from what was before, period of development of something NEW. All these words can apply to Christians who are living a NEW life given in God's dictionary. We can take each one of the following words from the bible and hear the Lord speaking blessing upon us for this New Year. Psalm 33:3 says, "Sing to God a NEW song; skillfully play with joyful chant. For the lord's word is true; all His works are trustworthy. The Lord loves justice and right and fills the earth with goodness." Psalm 40:1 – "I waited, waited for the Lord; who bent down and heard my cry, drew me out of the pit of destruction, out of the mud of the swamp, steadied my steps, and put a NEW song in my mouth, a hymn to our God." Isaiah 3:19 – "See, I am doing something NEW! Now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?" Isaiah 62:2 – "You shall be called by a NEW name pronounced by the mouth of the Lord." (A figurative expression for a NEW state of happiness). Lamentations 3:22 – "The favors of the Lord are not exhausted, His mercies are not spent; They are NEW each morning, so great is

His faithfulness." John 13:34 – "I give you a NEW commandment: 'Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.'" Ephesians 4:22 – "You should put away the old self of your former way of life, corrupted through deceitful desires, and be renewed in the spirit of your minds, and put on the NEW self, created in God's way in righteousness and holiness of truth." Revelation 21:3 – "Behold, God's dwelling is with the human race. He will dwell with them and they will be His people and God Himself will always be with them. He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there shall be no more death or mourning, wailing or pain, for the old order has passed away. The One who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things NEW."

These are just a few words taken from scripture in which our loving God speaks to us of NEW life and NEW found joy in obedience to Him. It is in these difficulties that we need His word to comfort and lift us up. He has not lost touch with us. He will never leave us or forsake us. He is a faithful and loving God at all times. As we grow

with the help of the Holy Spirit, we learn not to follow our feelings or emotions – they change from day to day. His love never changes. His concern and care for us is always the same. He loves us constantly and completely, every day, all the time, even when we fail Him. He is the great Lord of our whole life. For reasons that we humans find hard to understand, He finds delight in having fellowship with us. No matter how far we may run from Him, He continues to call us back. In the poem “The Hound of Heaven”, it tells of how our loving God searches for each one of us with His steadfast love. He does not let go of us even when we run from Him. He continues to love us and to call to us. If we listen we will hear Him say, “Arise, give me your hand. Behold, I make all things NEW.”
