## CONFERENCE BANNERS

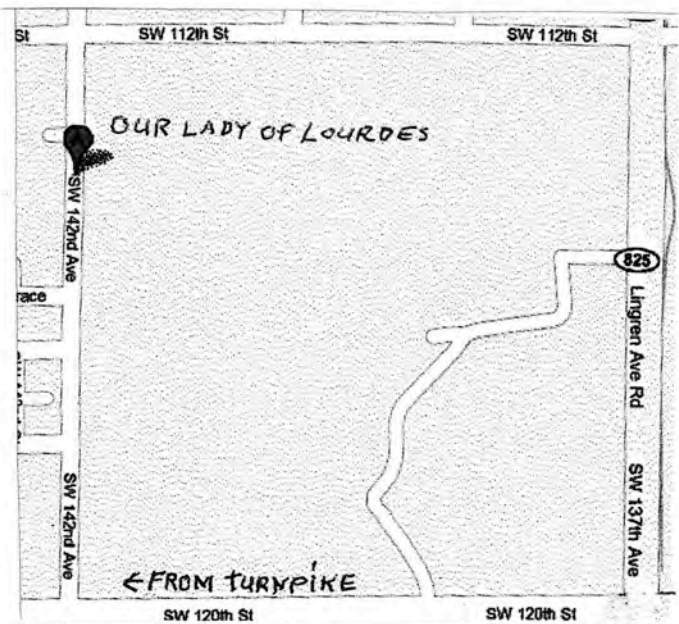

## THE POWER OF PRAISE

Praise is the form of prayer which recognizes most immediately that God is God. It lauds God for his own sake and gives him glory, quite beyond what he does, but simply because He IS. It shares in the blessed happiness of the pure of heart who love God in Faith before seeing him in glory. By praise, the Spirit is joined to our spirits to bear witness that we are children of God, testifying to the only son in whom we are adopted and by whom we glorify the Father. Praise embraces the other forms of prayer and carries them toward him who is the source and goal:

“one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist.” *From the Catechism of the Catholic Church page 635.*

Whenever we offer words of praise to God we are truly glorifying him for who He IS. In Psalm 50:23 we read: “Those who offer praise as a sacrifice honor me; to the obedient I will show the salvation of God”. Praise is powerful! Praise pleases God! We were created to praise and glorify him. Because of his love and mercy the Father sent his son into the world to teach us how to live and to take our sin upon himself so that we might have eternal life. Isaiah 53 tells us: “We had all gone astray like sheep, each following his own way; but the Lord laid upon him the guilt of us all.”

One of the many things we can praise the Lord for is the beautiful book of psalms. Sometimes we may have difficulty praying but as we begin to read the psalms we are inspired and lifted up. At times to praise requires will power and determination. For most people we go through dry times or times when we don't feel like praising. For some reason the natural man rebels against prayer, but as we persevere his presence fills our soul and we want to continue seeking him. In Psalm 34:1 David said, “I will bless the Lord at all times; praise shall always be in my mouth.”

Praise refreshes us spiritually, physically and mentally. When we are refreshed in prayer we are able to refresh others. We take in God's grace and then share it with those we meet. We may be tired from a long days work or from dealing with every-day life, but as we take time out and sit at the feet of Jesus, the burdens lift. Jesus is our resting place. Matthew 11:28

As we gather together as the Body of Christ to praise and worship our Lord, we experience the love and power of his Spirit touching us. He brings us peace, joy and strength to continue to serve him, our families and all those he puts in our path. When Jesus walked this earth, he did not walk alone. He was obedient to his Father and there were always other people seeking him for help and needing an encouraging word. If we are true followers of Jesus, our path will be the same as his – serving others.

The best habit we can ever form is to praise the Lord at all times. Our daily lives should praise and glorify him. The work of our hands and all that we say and do should praise him. As we gather for Mass and receive the sacraments our hearts should overflow with thanksgiving, worship and praise for all the abundant blessings the Father has bestowed upon his children. BLESS THE LORD MY SOUL; ALL MY BEING BLESS HIS HOLY NAME! BLESS THE LORD, MY SOUL; DO NOT FORGET ALL THE GIFTS OF GOD, WHO PARDONS ALL YOUR SINS, HEALS ALL YOUR ILLS, DELIVERS YOUR LIFE FROM THE PIT, SURROUNDS YOU WITH LOVE AND COMPASSION, FILLS YOUR DAYS WITH GOOD THINGS; YOUR YOUTH IS RENEWED LIKE THE EAGLE'S.
