THE ARCHDIOCESE OF MIAMI IS AUTHORIZED UNDER FEDERAL LAW TO ENROLL NON-IMMIGRANT ALIEN STUDENTS AND ISSUE I-20 CERTIFICATES IN ORDER TO OBTAIN “F-1” STATUS. IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE, PLEASE LET THE SCHOOL KNOW AT REGISTRATION.

Our school, in accordance with federal law, does not inquire into the immigration status of our students.

However, it is our responsibility to remind all families that it is a violation of the tourist B-1 or B-2 visa to attend classes while on a B-1 or B-2 visa, and doing so could result in cancellation of that visa.

If a family is considering changing a B-1 or B-2 Tourist Visa for an F-1 student visa, they should consult with an immigration lawyer to help understand the implications of making application. Should the family decide to make this application, St. Bartholomew Catholic School will assist a family in whatever way possible to apply for the student visa. **It often takes several months for INS to process and approve such applications; during this period the student may not continue attending classes in the school.**
